

Florida Caverns is part of the State Park system in Florida. It is located in the Florida Panhandle near Marianna. It is the only Florida State Park with fresh air filled caves accessible to the public.

The Limestone caves in the park have Stalagmites, Stalactites, and flowstones formed by the erosion of the bedrock. Other formations are above ground, including rivers and springs

Florida caverns State park and the neighboring golf courses were constructed by the Civilian Conservation Corps as part of the New Deal/ The park opened for visitors in 1942.

Park Features

The park is notable for it's geological features, a protected area of karst topography. This geology hosts an ecosystem with plants and animals that are adapted to the limestone substrates. Native Americans inhabited the area and it is a site of archaeological interest.

The park allows nature study, exploring, hiking, boating, horseback riding, and fishing. There is a visitor center with interpretive exhibits, and concessions. The park Rangers conduct tours daily.
